



Elementary After School Soccer Program



Dear Parents,

Our extensive after school athletic program is approaching. Our first sport is soccer. This sheet should provide the information you need about the program.

Please fill out the attached registration form and return it to the school with the fee.

- When:** Elementary soccer runs from October 31st until November 18th
- Days:** Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Fridays from 3:30 – 5:00 p.m. Children must be picked up on the football field and signed out from soccer. Children not picked up at 5:15 p.m. will be taken to aftercare. You will be charged an aftercare fee if your child is not picked up by 5:15 p.m.
- Cost:** \$65.00...please make check payable to Colonial Hills Christian School or CHCS. Drop your child's registration form off at the receptionist desk or put it in your child's folder.
- What to Bring:** Your child needs to bring the following with them on soccer days: sports drink or water, shorts, and T shirt, sweats for cold days. Cleats and shin guards are recommended but are not mandatory. Your child will be given a soccer shirt for the team they are placed on.

QUESTIONS THAT ARE COMMONLY ASKED:

- 1. What happens if it rains?** If there is no lightening or thunder and it is not pouring we will still have soccer.
- 2. What if soccer is cancelled?** If soccer is cancelled, every effort will be made to contact the parent via the phone number provided on the registration form. If the parent cannot be contacted and they are not a regular aftercare student, the student will be taken to after care at no charge. In case of weather the decision to cancel will be made near the end of the school day, usually around 2:00 p.m. You may always call the school office to check if a day has been cancelled.
- 3. Make up days:** If a day has been cancelled, the program will be extended after Thanksgiving to make up the missed days. Flyers will be sent home with your child as well as posted at the elementary building entrance.
- 4. How does the program work?** The children are split into two divisions; 1st – 3rd grade and 4th – 6th grade. They are taught the basic fundamental skills and placed on teams within their divisions. We need volunteer parents to help out with taking students to the bathroom and being a team coach. **If you would be interested in helping out, please contact Coach Will Little at 678-300-7905. Students whose parents volunteer to assist in the program will have their \$65.00 fee waived.**
